

Requirements for Students to receive Medication during the school day

Please provide the health office with the Wantagh Public Schools Medication Form completed by a physician and signed by a parent/guardian (form available on the school website or in the health office).

Medication must be in a pharmacy labeled medication bottle.

- The required medication form completed by the physician and signed by the parent must include the medication name, dosage, and route along with time and frequency medication is to be administered. The diagnosis and/or reason for administration must be also be included.
- Please note “A pharmacy label is not an order and cannot be used in place of a written provider order.
- Medication must be brought in by an adult in a pharmacy labeled vial/container.
- The pharmacy label must display the following: student name, name and phone number of pharmacy, license providers name, date and number of refills, name of medication/dosage, frequency of administration, route of administration and any other directions.
